Summer Daze 2017 will be offered at the YWCA in downtown Waterloo and at Highland Elementary in Waterloo. The Highland site will serve all ages, 4 - 12. At the YWCA, registration is limited to those entering 1st grade and older.

REGISTRATION CHECKLIST:

First, decide which payment category fits your family's needs and establish financial aid or 3rd party funding. See information under Reduced Pricing.

All paperwork and fees must be submitted at the time of registration.

- * Physical (age 4 only)
- * Membership (waived for DHS and HeadStart families)
- * Registration Fee
- * Deposit for each week reserved (waived for DHS and HeadStart families)

Cost: \$110/week members, \$140/week nonmembers

Save money with a youth membership! \$15 a year for children ages 13 and under. When registering, pay a \$10 deposit for each week your child will attend, with the remaining balance due before the beginning of each week. A one time, non-refundable \$15 activity/supply fee is also due at the time of registration. (\$30 maximum per household)

Reduced Pricing is available for Summer Daze. Based on household size and income the YWCA gives discounts of either 33% or 66%. Earlier approval for a different program, such as Y's Kids, Playdays, swimming lessons, etc., does not apply. Application for financial aid must be made specifically for Summer Daze on or after March 13, 2017.

For our licensed child care programs, the YWCA participates in DHS child care, JPTA, and other alternative funding sources such as those approved for Wrap Around Services through Tri County Head Start. The YWCA must have written authorization from the funding source before service may begin. No child receiving DHS funds can begin the program without notification of approval from the Department of Human Services.

Registration will begin 7:00am, Monday, May 1, 2017, for Y's Kids before-and-after school child care for 2017 - 2018

The YWCA provides before-and-after school care for school age children at: Highland, Irving, Kingsley, Kittrell, Lincoln, Lou Henry, Lowell in Waterloo, at Hansen, Lincoln and North Cedar in Cedar Falls and at Hudson Elementary. After school programming is offered at Cunningham Elementary.

The YWCA provides child care for children in Head Start and Preschool programs at: Cunningham, Elk Run, Highland, Kittrell, and Lincoln in Waterloo.
